Call for Papers INFER Special Session

The INFER Special Session provides an excellent opportunity for members and non-members of INFER alike to exchange ideas and to discuss results from recent economic research. Therefore, the aim of this special session during the CEBC 2024 conference is to bring together scholars, researchers and policy makers who share the same interests in finding answers and providing solutions to current challenges. The special session is open to contributions from all areas of economics. We welcome both empirical and theoretical papers related to the following non-exhaustive list of topics: environmental sustainability, sustainable development, economic growth, foreign trade, circular economy, welfare economics, fiscal policy, monetary policy. Among the speakers, we will have the honour to have with us Professor Prof. Inmaculada Martínez-Zarzoso, Ph.D. She is a professor at the universities of Göttingen (Germany) and at Jaume I (Spain) and also First Vice Chair INFER. Her topic will be on Environmental and Trade Policies to Decarbonize Global Value Chains.

INFER Special Session Paper Submission Procedure

Full papers may be submitted to the INFER special session organizers at the email address cebc@econ.ubbcluj.ro by September 20, 2024. Authors are allowed to submit only one paper to this special session. All submitted papers will be peer-reviewed according to a high-quality and fast referee process. Authors will be notified whether their paper is accepted for presentation at the special session no later than October 8, 2024. Special session presenters are expected to discuss the papers during the session. The assignment of discussants will be made by the conference organizers.

The authors accepted at the INFER Special Session are invited to submit their papers to special issue in **Journal of Applied Economics** until January 25, 2024. The topic of the special issue is Energy and Environmental Sustainability.

Papers must be in English and must include a cover page with the following information:

- An abstract of up to 500 words, with JEL classification and no more than 5 keywords
- Authors' full name and affiliation
- Contact details for corresponding (e-mail)
