Students from UBB-FSEGA attending Fairfield University, Dolan School of Business will be required by federal regulations to enroll in a minimum of 12 credit hours during the exchange term. Students my take up to but no more than 15 credit hours during the exchange term. Courses will be from among those offered during the student's mobility term and a final list of classes will have to be agreed on at least 6 months prior to student departure.
