

Avinash Dixit earned a B.Sc. in mathematics and physics at St. Xavier's College (Bombay, today Mumbai), a B.A. in mathematics at Corpus Christi College, the University of Cambridge, and a Ph.D. in economics at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. He became faculty member of Princeton in January 1981, after serving as an assistant professor at the University of California–Berkeley, a fellow of Balliol College, the University of Oxford, and a professor at the University of Warwick. He is the John J. F. Sherrerd '52 University Professor of Economics at Princeton. Professor Dixit is also a fellow of the Econometric Society, the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, and the National Academy of Sciences, a corresponding fellow of the British Academy, and a recently elected member of the American Philosophical Society. He is widely regarded as one of the leading economists of his generation, with seminal contributions to an extraordinary range of subfields that includes microeconomics, international macroeconomics, economic growth and development, and the law and institutions of economic governance.

<u>Cosmin Ilut</u> is an associate professor in the Economics Department at Duke University, and a Faculty Research Fellow in the National Bureau of Economic Research (NBER), Economic Fluctuations and Growth program. Since 2017, Cosmin is Associate Editor of the Journal of Monetary Economics. His research in macroeconomics focuses on the effects of ambiguity on business cycles dynamics and financial assets using dynamic general equilibrium models. His publications span a wide range of top economic journals such as American Economic Review, Review of Economic Studies, Journal of Political Economy, Journal of Monetary Economics. Cosmin holds a PhD in Economics from Northwestern University, a MA in Economics from Central European University, while the BA is from the Babeş-Bolyai University, Faculty of Economics and Business Administration.

Benny Moldovanu is professor at University of Bonn, where he currently holds the Chair of Economic Theory II. At Bonn University, he has been the Co-Director and Academic Director of the Bonn Graduate School of Economics (2006–13), as well as Co-Director of the Hausdorff Center for Mathematics (2006–13), and he is currently Director of the Institute of Microeconomics (since 2012) and of the Reinhard Selten Institute for Research in Economics (since 2017). His research has been published in top journals and focuses on applied game theory, auction theory, mechanism design, contests and matching theory, and voting theory. He has been associated editor at Journal of Economic Theory (2001-09), Games and Economic Behavior (2002-07) and Econometrica (2002-08). Professor Moldovanu was awarded the Gossen Prize for his contributions to auction theory and mechanism design, an ERC Advanced Grant from the European Research Council and several grants from the German Science Foundation.

Enrico Perotti (PhD Finance, MIT 1990) is Professor of International Finance at the University of Amsterdam. His research in banking and corporate finance, organization theory, political economy, legal and financial history has appeared in the top economics and finance journals. He has held visiting appointments at MIT, Harvard, Oxford, Columbia Business School, London Business School, LSE and the IMF. He acted as consultant to the EC, IMF, FSB, World Bank and DNB. He was the 2011 Houblon Normal Fellow in financial stability at the Bank of England and 2015 Wim Duisenberg Fellow at the ECB. He is Fellow of the European Economic Association and Research Fellow at CEPR and Tinbergen Institute.



Avinash Dixit are licenta in matematica si fizica de la St. Xavier's College (orasul Bombay, actual Mumbai), licenta in matematica de la Corpus Christi College din cadrul University of Cambridge, iar studiile doctorale in economie le-a finalizat la Massachusetts Institute of Technology. A devenit cadru didactic la Princeton in ianuarie 1981, dupa ce a activat ca si professor asistent la University of California–Berkeley, a fost cadru didactic asociat la Balliol College din cadrul University of Oxford, si profesor la University of Warwick. In acest moment este John J. F. Sherrerd '52 University Professor in economie la Princeton. Profesorul Dixit este membru al Econometric Society, al American Academy of Arts and Sciences, precum si al National Academy of Sciences. De asemenea este membru correspondent al British Academy, si a fost ales recent membru al American Philosophical Society. Este privit ca unul dintre cei mai importanti economisti ai generatiei sale, cu contributii fundamentale in numeroase subdomenii ale stiintelor economice precum microeconomie, teoria jocurilor, economie publica, economie urbana, comert international, organizare industriala, macroeconomie, macroeconomie internationala, crestere si dezvoltare economica si nu in ultimul rand, legi si institutii ale guvernantei economice.

<u>Cosmin Ilut</u> este Associate Professor in cadrul Departamentului de Economie al Duke University si Faculty Research Fellow in cadrul programului Economic Fluctuations and Growth al National Bureau of Economic Research. Incepand cu 2017, Cosmin este Associate Editor al Journal of Monetary Economics. Cercetarile sale se axeaza pe domeniul macroeconomiei, evidentiind in special efectele ambiguitatii asupra ciclurilor de afaceri si activelor financiare folosind modele dinamice de echilibru general. Publicatiile sale acopera o gama larga de reviste economice de top, cum ar fi: American Economic Review, Econometrica, Review of Economic Studies si International Economic Review, Review of Economic Studies, Journal of Political Economy, Journal of Monetary Economics. Cosmin are un doctorat in economie obtinut in 2009 la Northwestern University. Studiile masterale au fost efectuate in cadrul Central European University, iar cele de licenta in cadrul FSEGA, Universitatea Babeş-Bolyai.

Benny Moldovanu este profesor la Universitatea Bonn, unde detine pozitia de Chair of Economic Theory II. La Universitatea Bonn, a fost co-director si director academic al Bonn Graduate School of Economics (2006-13), precum si co-director al Hausdorff Center for Mathematics (2006-13), iar in prezent este directorul Institutul de Microeconomie (din 2012) si al Institutul Reinhard Selten pentru Cercetare in Economie (din 2017). Cercetarea sa a fost publicata in reviste de top si se concentreaza asupra teoriei jocurilor aplicata, teoriei licitatiilor, designului mecanismelor economice, teoriei concursurilor, teoriei matchingului, si respectiv asupra teoriei votarii. A fost editor asociat la Journal of Economic Theory (2001-09), Games and Economic Behavior (2002-07) si Econometrica (2002-08). Profesorul Moldovanu a primit Premiul Gossen pentru contributiile sale la teoria licitatiei si designul mecanismelor economice, un grant pentru cercetare avansata de la European Research Council si mai multe granturi de la German Science Foundation.

Enrico Perotti (Doctorat in finante, MIT 1990) este Professor of International Finance la University of Amsterdam. Cercetarea profesorului Perotti acopera discipline variate precum teoria bancara si finante, teoria organizatiei, economie politica, istoria dreptului si a finantelor. A fost publicata in reviste stiintifice de top. Profesorul Perotti a avut pozitii de "visiting" la MIT, Harvard, Oxford, Columbia Business School, London Business School, LSE si IMF. A oferit consultanta pentru mai multe organizatii internationale si nationale precum Comisia Europeana, FMI, Financial Stability Board, Banca Mondiala si Banca Centrala a Olandei. In 2011 a fost "Houblon Normal Fellow" in domeniul stabilitatii financiare la Banca Angliei iar in 2015 a fost "Wim Duisenberg Fellow" la Banca Central Europeana. Profesorul Perotti este de-asemenea "Fellow" al European Economic Association, al CEPR si al Institutului Tinbergen.
